

SNPMace Project – Aims "International SNP Evaluations" as a new Interbull Service "SNPMace" principles (Meta-analysis) · exploiting summary statistics from each country's national genomic evaluation: LD matrices Not shared SNPs' frequencies among More accurate SNPs' effects participants population-specific error variance in the population **SNP** effects Considers correlations among different populations In the research phase of the project, the meta-analysis generated gEBV having correlations in the range of 0.99 to 1 with those obtained by using raw information



SNPMace – Expected Benefits

- Improves the accuracy of SNP effect estimates compared to within-country SNP solutions
- No need of sharing/exchanging/pooling genotypes on individual bulls or cows
- Use female information from national reference populations at the international level.

Interbull Business Model Principles

- a) The Interbull Centre works on a non-profit basis
- b) Service fee to be set at a level of cost recovery:
 - Service Users cover the full direct cost;
 - May be different by Breed x Trait Group combination:
 - > Benefits from SNPMace services
 - > Population sizes
 - > Open vs Closed Groups



SNPMace Service Options (1)

- Open Service (similar to current service):
 - > Anyone can participate
 - > Results are shared with all other participants
 - > Fees invoiced to each participating organization as for other Interbull services
- Closed Groups (new):
 - > The group defines who is involved in the service run, informs the Interbull Centre and defines the desired Breed x Trait Group combinations
 - > Results are only shared within each group
 - > Single "full cost" invoice provided to designated "lead" entity with cost sharing determined internally within each group




Purpose of the Survey

- Assess the level of understanding of the proposed business model for SNPMace services;
